Mi'kmaw Kina'matnewey is currently seeking applicants for the position of Mi'kmaw Language Coordinator. This position will be based out of Membertou, N.S.

The role of the Coordinator is to encourage and promote Mi'kmaw best practices and approaches, while building capacity and providing access to relevant and quality material to institutions in member communities. The incumbent will lead research into selected topics to ensure that teachers are using up to date materials and resources for their interactions with students. In addition, manage the maintenance and development of the Mi'kmaw dictionary.

Qualified applicants will be fluent in Mi'kmaw (oral, reading, writing) and English, with a B.Ed. (or equivalent), and two years' experience in teaching or as a project lead, or similar related experience. A teachers' license is required (candidates without a teaching license with significant experience in curriculum development *may* be considered).
